



LANDLORD APPROVAL FOR THE INSTALLATION OF LOTTERY GAMING COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT

Lottery Retailers with a lease agreement must have their landlord's approval for IGT, the Lottery's Online Gaming vendor, to install communications equipment on the roof and run cables.

Prior to installation of an Flex® Terminal in the retailer's location, IGT will need to install a satellite dish on the building's roof. In most cases and wherever possible, installers will use non-penetrating mounts to secure the dish. Installers will use cabling to connect the outdoor equipment to an indoor receiver unit. Whenever possible, installers will use existing holes in the building to run cables. If it is necessary to drill a hole in the building, the installer will ask for permission from the retailer. For further information, you may request an IGT Online Terminal System flyer, Certificate of Liability Insurance, and/or letter concerning the use of non-penetrating roof mounts.
