



## LOTTO PLUS™ FAQ's

### 1. What is LOTTO PLUS™?

LOTTO PLUS is a FLORIDA LOTTO™ option that offers players the opportunity to play for millions more in addition to the base jackpot. \$2 LOTTO PLUS jackpots start at \$13 million – the base jackpot plus an additional \$10 million, and \$3 LOTTO PLUS jackpots start at \$28 million – the base jackpot, the additional \$10 million and another \$15 million, for a total of \$25 million added to the base jackpot!

### 2. With LOTTO PLUS added to FLORIDA LOTTO, can I use my old playslip to play the game?

Since the new options were added to FLORIDA LOTTO on March 2, 2008, new FLORIDA LOTTO playslips are required to play the game. The new playslips are available at more than 13,000 Florida Lottery retailers statewide.

### 3. How do can I play LOTTO PLUS?

Playing LOTTO PLUS is easy. Just complete a playslip as follows:

- 1) Decide how many plays you want to play, and fill out one panel per play.
- 2) Select the amount you would like to play in each panel. To play classic LOTTO, select \$1; to play \$2 LOTTO PLUS, select \$2; and, to play \$3 LOTTO PLUS, select \$3.
- 3) Select six numbers from 1 through 53 in each panel or mark the Quick Pick (QP) box for the terminal to randomly pick some or all of your numbers for you.

Or, if you don't want to use a playslip, simply ask your Florida Lottery retailer for "LOTTO", "\$2 LOTTO PLUS" or "\$3 LOTTO PLUS".

### 4. If I select different prices in each panel on a playslip, will I get a separate ticket for each price?

No. You will receive all of your plays (up to 10) on one ticket. The price of each of your plays will be printed on the ticket.

### 5. If the price of my new FLORIDA LOTTO ticket is more than what I want to spend, can I cancel my ticket?

Yes. FLORIDA LOTTO tickets, including LOTTO PLUS, may be cancelled by the original selling terminal; however, tickets must be cancelled within two hours of the sales transaction, that day's close of sales, or the end of the gaming system business day (whichever occurs first).

### 6. Are there any changes to the FLORIDA LOTTO base game?

No. Players may continue to play FLORIDA LOTTO the way they always have. The 6-of-53 game matrix, odds of winning, and the prizes remain unchanged.

#### FLORIDA LOTTO Prizes and Odds

\*If no FLORIDA LOTTO ticket matches all six winning numbers, the base jackpot rolls over and the cash in the base jackpot prize pool is carried over to the next drawing. The \$2 and \$3 LOTTO PLUS jackpot prize pools will not be carried over.

\*\*The estimated prize payout to each winner is based on averages of previous payouts. Actual prize amounts vary depending on sales and the number of winners in each prize category.

**7. Will I be able to purchase Advance Play draws for \$2 and \$3 LOTTO PLUS?**

Yes. The amount you play on each panel will apply to all Advance Play draws selected. For example, if you play 10 panels at \$3 each and select 2 Advance Play drawings on your playslip, your total cost will be \$60 (10 plays x \$3 each x 2 draws).

**8. How does the new game affect my Grouper purchase?**

\$2 and \$3 LOTTO PLUS tickets are not available for purchase with GROUPER®. If you purchase a GROUPER ticket, the terminal will automatically select a \$1 FLORIDA LOTTO play.

**9. Do the \$2 and \$3 LOTTO PLUS jackpots rollover?**

No, only the base jackpot rolls over. However, regardless of the base jackpot's roll level, the \$2 LOTTO PLUS jackpot will always be \$10 million more than the base jackpot and the \$3 LOTTO PLUS jackpot will always be \$25 million more than the base jackpot.

**FLORIDA LOTTO Jackpot Example:**

Please Note: The base jackpot amounts in the chart above are only examples. The actual amounts will vary depending on several factors including draw sales and annuity interest rates.

**10. If I play \$2 or \$3 LOTTO PLUS, will my prize for matching 3-of-6, 4-of-6, or 5-of-6 numbers be higher too?**

No. At this time, \$2 and \$3 LOTTO PLUS players will win the same lower-tier prizes as \$1 LOTTO players. The \$2 and \$3 LOTTO PLUS plays are add-ons only to the base jackpot.

**11. Are the \$2 and \$3 LOTTO PLUS advertised jackpot amounts cash prizes and are they shared if there are multiple winners?**

All FLORIDA LOTTO advertised jackpots are the amount the Lottery will pay a single winner in 30 annual payments. If there are multiple 6-of-6 winners, the jackpot prizes will be shared equally within the applicable prize pool. Winners of the \$2 and \$3 LOTTO PLUS jackpots will win their share of the applicable prize pool as well as their share of the lesser jackpot prize pools.

**12. Is the Cash Option available on \$2 and \$3 LOTTO PLUS jackpot prizes?**

Yes. Players may choose to receive their portion of a FLORIDA LOTTO jackpot – including LOTTO PLUS jackpots – in a one-time, lump-sum payment (Cash Option) or in 30 annual payments. The Cash Option payment is the amount required on the day of the drawing (or if the drawing is held on a Saturday or holiday, the business day prior to the drawing) to fund the applicable jackpot prize paid over 30 years, less applicable taxes.

**13. Are jackpot prizes shared if there are multiple winners?**

Yes. All FLORIDA LOTTERY jackpots – including \$2 and \$3 LOTTO PLUS jackpots – are shared among all eligible winners. \$2 LOTTO PLUS players will win a share of the \$1 jackpot pool and a share or all of the \$2 jackpot pool. \$3 LOTTO PLUS players will win a share of the \$1 jackpot pool, a share or all of the \$2 jackpot pool and a share or all of the \$3 jackpot pool.

**Example of a shared jackpot with three jackpot winners** (one of which played \$1 LOTTO, one which played \$2 LOTTO PLUS and one which played \$3 LOTTO PLUS): Each winner will receive 1/3 of the base jackpot prize; the \$2 and \$3 LOTTO PLUS players will each receive 1/2 of the \$10 million from the \$2 jackpot prize pool; and, the \$3 LOTTO PLUS player will receive the entire \$15 million from the \$3 jackpot prize pool. If the base jackpot is \$3 million, the \$1 player will win \$1 million, the \$2 LOTTO PLUS player will win \$6 million and the \$3 LOTTO PLUS player will win \$21 million.
