Florida Lottery Open Government Bill of Rights

Members of the public are entitled to be treated with respect, courtesy and professionalism when interacting with the Department of the Lottery.

Access to public records and meetings of collegial bodies are rights secured under Sections 119.07(1) and 286.011, Florida Statutes and Article 1, Section 24, Florida Constitution.

Public records requests are not required to be made in writing.

All public record requests shall be acknowledged promptly and responded to in good faith as required by Section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes.

Information that is confidential by law will be redacted from public records prior to responding to a public records request.

Fees for production of public record documents shall not exceed the statutorily authorized fees and the statutory authority for such fees shall be cited.

The public has the right to receive an itemized invoice of proposed fees or fees charged, if requested.
